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General Dynamics Bath Iron Works has awarded Howell Laboratories, Inc. a firm-fixed-price multi-ship contract to provide our 7600 ECOLCELL chlorinators for DDG 113 and follow. The 7600 ECOLCELL reduces unscheduled maintenance and overhaul of cooling systems and engines by generating hypochlorite, which is acknowledged as being the best antifouling agent against both micro- and macro-fouling.

DDG 113 is the first ship of the DDG 51 Class Restart program. HLI has been providing BIW & Northrup Grumman Shipbuilding Systems – Ingalls 7600 ECOLCELL chlorinators for the Arleigh Burke Class destroyers since DDG 100.

DDG 51 Class destroyers are warships that provide multi-mission offensive and defensive capabilities. The destroyers can operate independently or as part of carrier strike groups, surface action groups, amphibious ready groups, and underway replenishment groups.
